

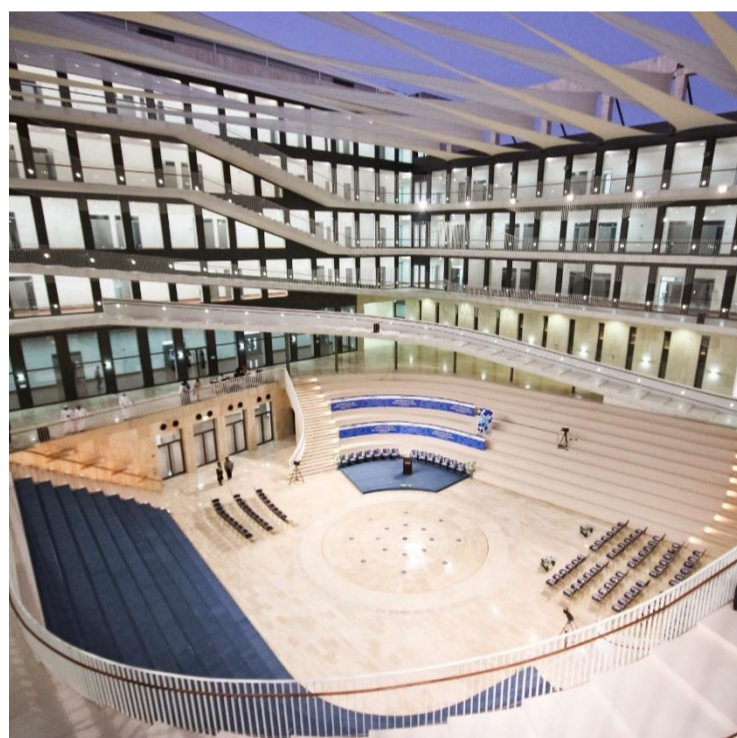
Internship Oman
