

Tokyo Tech Summer Program 2018

-Research-oriented Program-

Call for Applications

In 2018, Tokyo Institute of Technology (Tokyo Tech) offers a summer program for undergraduate and graduate students to pursue **individual research projects** under Tokyo Tech faculty supervision.

In addition, participants will have opportunities to learn about Japanese culture while experiencing life in one of the most exciting and technologically-advanced cities in the world.

Summer Program Overview:

Participants in a research-oriented program will conduct individual research projects in Tokyo Tech labs under the guidance of Tokyo Tech faculty supervision.

Students can also take one or two courses offered in the summer program with the permission of their academic supervisors.

Period of Program :

June 5 – August 10, 2018 (10 weeks)

Eligibility:

- **Undergraduate students** majoring in science and engineering-related fields who have completed their second year by the time of participation
- **Graduate students** in science and engineering-related fields

Number of Participants:

Up to 40 students will be selected to participate

Research and Courses offered:

- **Research Project (2 credits) *compulsory**
- **Japan Studies (2 credits) *compulsory**
- **Japanese for Beginners (1 credit) *optional**

Credit Transfer:

Tokyo Tech can issue an academic record and a certificate of completion. How credits are transferred depends on the student's home university.

Japanese Cultural Experience:

Participants can experience Japanese culture through a number of cultural and social activities, such as home visit program, tea ceremony, and club activities with Tokyo Tech students.



Program Expenses:

Program Fee

30,000 JPY (267 USD, 1 USD ≒ 112 JPY as of Oct. 2017)

Application, Admission, and Tuition

The following fees will be waived:

Application 9,800 JPY, Admission 84,600 JPY, Tuition 29,700 JPY/month

Accommodation

200,000 - 240,000 JPY in total (1,778 - 2,134 USD, 1 USD ≒ 112 JPY as of Oct. 2017) *subject to change
Off-campus accommodations will be reserved by Tokyo Tech.

Air Ticket, Local Transportation and Other Living Cost

At the participant's expense.

Scholarships

A limited number of qualified students may be able to receive a JASSO or Tokyo Tech fund scholarship. Those awarded will be informed one or two months before beginning their studies.
