Language Requirement	<p>Exchange students should have sufficient English language skills to follow classes (at least level B1).</p> <p>Students should pass the Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) with a minimum score of 5 if they would like to follow Chinese-taught courses.</p>	

<p>Course Selection</p>	<p>Incoming exchange students can select courses across a range of subject areas and are not restricted to courses only in their disciplines. It is possible for undergraduate exchange students to choose courses from postgraduate programs, and vice versa. Exchange students are able to change their choices after arrival at Beihang.</p> <p>Some courses are taught only once a year, either in the spring semester or in the autumn semester. One credit at Beihang generally equals to 16 hours of lecture time, around 2 – 2.5 ECTS credits. <p>Chinese Language Courses</p>	<p>Yes. Application for such courses takes place upon arrival. Students cannot only choose Chinese Language courses if their field of study at their home university is NOT Chinese Language and Literature (or related areas).</p>
<p>Research Projects</p>	<p>Students who wish to conduct research projects at Beihang University need to get in touch with professor of Beihang and get their permission before applying for visa. Starting from AY 2020-21, we will not be able to give any credits for conducting research projects, but we will offer students with evaluation form as assessment for their home university.</p>
<p>Application Documents</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <i>Application Form</i> 2. <i>Study Plan</i> 3. <i>Copy of Passport (Personal Information page)</i> 4. <i>Official Transcript</i> 5. <i>Curriculum Vitae/Resume</i> 6. <i>Recommendation List (completed by home university)</i> <p>Before the deadlines, home university should send a recommendation list (xls. format) and a single PDF file containing the other application documents to the program manager of the corresponding regions.</p>
<p>Health Insurance</p>	<p>Compulsory. The cost is 400 RMB for 6 months, paid upon arrival.</p>
<p>On-campus Accommodation</p>	<p>Double-occupancy bedroom with a shared bathroom at the International Student Dormitory (Building 10, Da Yun Cun). There is no single-room option. The monthly rent is around 650 RMB. *Chinese citizens (including Hong Kong, Taiwan, and Macao residents) have to live with other Chinese students in a four-occupancy bedroom with a shared bathroom.</p>
<p>Visa Requirements</p>	<p>Beihang University will send an Acceptance Letter along with the JW201/JW202 form for each student. We will not be able to issue a residence permit to exchange students. Students who have applied and are accepted for one-year exchange will apply for X2 visa (shorter than 6</p>

	months), and by the end of the first semester, we will extend their visa to the end of the second semester (which means students will get another 6-month of stay).
Transcripts	The transcript of record will be available in the first month of the following semester and will be posted to coordinators at our partner universities upon request.
