

Online Course „Consent Matters“

The Equal Opportunities Office acquired access data for the online course "Consent Matters: Boundaries, Respect and Positive Intervention" of Oxford University Press. This interactive course in English addresses students specifically and covers the meaning of consent in relationships and self-determination in the university context. Therefore, its purpose is to promote an understanding of the issue and a respectful togetherness free of harassment within the University.

The course is very interesting and vividly designed with example scenarios. It can be conducted quickly within approximately one hour. Processing the course helps to improve the understanding of consent and self-determination.
